

## Information regarding ski trip arranged by Grennaskolan

This is written in order to clarify the responsibility of students participating in excursions arranged by Grennaskolan. The conditions are the same regardless of whether students participation is voluntary or compulsory. Participation in a trip of this nature requires good judgement and responsibility by everyone involved. In order to ensure a positive experience for everyone the school has set up the following requirements for participation:

- Very good presence in class and other activities.
  - Good record of respecting school rules.
  - Good academic results.
- Students who risk not meeting the requirements in their subjects or courses due to not meeting deadlines for assignments and tests run the risk of not being allowed to go. IB-students need to make sure they meet all deadlines in the academic calendar.

This a school activity and takes place during the school week even if it is off the school premises. Students therefore represent the school are required to follow the directions given by school staff. The school rules apply. If you are uncertain about something you must consult the school staff. Should a student ignore given instructions or misbehave in other ways the staff has the right to organise a return journey for that student at his or her own expense. Any such discussion needs to be taken in consultation with the head of the school.

Oliver Lawrence, deputy head, is responsible for this trip to Vemdalen during February 4 to February 7. This is a skiing trip that takes place when the school's other students have sports days in Gränna. The purpose is that all participating students engage in snowboarding or cross country- and downhill skiing. For those who are beginners we will arrange skiing instruction.

The total cost of the trip is 2000 kr which includes the bus, cabin, food and skipass for three days. In addition to this students need to take into account personal expenses they may incur should they need to rent equipment or entry fees for the nightclub etc. The registration fee is 800 kr and this corresponds to the cost of the cabin. The registration fee is non-refundable should students change their minds about participating in the trip as the cabins cannot be cancelled after the final date of registration. The final registration date for the trip is **Friday September 4 2009**.
